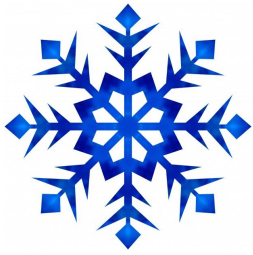
Why reading daily is soooo important!
